

DECISION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN INSTITUTE OF INNOVATION AND TECHNOLOGY (EIT) of 15 September 2011

on the conditions for EIT labelled degrees and diplomas

THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN INSTITUTE OF INNOVATION AND TECHNOLOGY,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No. 294/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11th March 2008, hereinafter called the "Regulation", establishing the European Institute of Innovation and Technology, hereinafter called the "EIT", and in particular to Article 8 on "Degrees and Diplomas";

Whereas:

- The prerequisite for labelling degrees and diplomas awarded by the Higher Education institutions participating in the KICs as "EIT degrees and diplomas" is the application of the provisions and the initial set of "quality criteria included in the Framework Partnership Agreement (FPA).
- To implement the initial set of quality criteria included in the FPA, the Higher Education Institutions participating in the KICs need more specific requirements.

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

Conditions for labelled degrees and diplomas

The annexed conditions for EIT labelled degrees and diplomas, including the EIT overarching learning outcomes are to be applied.

With a view to safeguard the quality of the EIT labelled degrees, the EIT reserves the right to revoke the "EIT label" should the established conditions not be applied accordingly and/or consistently.

Article 2 Entry into force

This decision shall enter into force on the date of its signature.
