

Privacy statement regarding the “EIT Education and Skills Days” organised on 15-16 October 2025

This privacy statement provides information relating to the processing of personal data by the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT), EIT Health e.V., EIT Raw Materials GmbH, EIT Manufacturing ASBL, KIC InnoEnergy SE. It will be an hybrid event (in presence and online): “**EIT Education and Skills Days**” organised on 15-16 October 2025 in Brussels.

The processing of personal data of the data subjects follows the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices, and agencies and on the free movement of such data¹ (hereinafter “Regulation”).

The processing of personal data of the data subjects follows the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the KICs and on the free movement of such data (hereinafter “GDPR²”).

What is personal data, and what is personal data processing?

Personal data shall mean any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person (“data subject”). An identifiable person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person.

Processing means any operation or set of operations which is performed on personal data or on sets of personal data, whether or not by automated means, such as collection, recording, organisation, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure or destruction.

Who is the controller?

Who are the data subjects (in particular)?

Speakers and attendees participating at the “EIT Education and Skills Days” organised on 15-16 October 2025. The attendees include minors between the ages of 13 and 18 years old.

The Controllers may process the personal data of minors under the age of 18 in connection with their participation in the event. In line with Article 8 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), *“where the data subject is below the age of 16, such processing will only take place based on the prior consent of a person holding parental responsibility for the child. The Controllers will take all necessary steps to verify that valid consent has been obtained and that the individual providing it has the legal authority to do so. Additional safeguards will be implemented to ensure that the personal data of minors is handled with the highest level of care and protection.”*. In particular, the consent of the minors have already been provided to EIT RawMaterials GmbH by the persons holding parental rights which covers the participation of the minors in such events.

What is the purpose of the personal data processing?

The EIT Education & Skills Days is a two-day hybrid event that will showcase how the EIT contributes to EU-level policy priorities. By aligning its flagship educational initiatives with these priorities, the EIT demonstrates its role in supporting Europe’s innovation capacity, job creation, and long-term competitiveness.

The EIT Education & Skills Days serves as a dynamic platform for showcasing and amplifying EIT’s major initiatives— the Higher Education Initiative (HEI), STEM Tech Talent Induction (currently known as the Deep Tech Talent Initiative), the EIT Skills Academies, and the Girls Go STEM (currently known as the Girls Go Circular programme). These initiatives are part of a coherent, strategic portfolio of coordinated education actions aimed at boosting Europe’s talent pipeline, enabling lifelong learning, and building a future-ready workforce.

The processing of the personal data is necessary for the following purposes:

- To manage the conference, including registration and participation of speakers and attendees.
- To include participants, upon their consent, in the

- To record and disseminate the conference audio, video recording on the Youtube and LinkedIn Channel of EIT and photos.

- Social media (Youtube, LinkedIn) and websites of EIT and the EIT Initiatives organising the event.

What types of personal data are processed?

Registration is needed for participation in the event. Only registered participants can attend the event. During registration, all participants — including both general attendees and speakers — will be asked to provide the same personal data: their name, email address, and the name of their organisation.

The event will be recorded for dissemination purposes. This includes the collection of audio and video footage of speakers, as well as their names, and may incidentally include the names and images of attendees. Photographs may also be taken during the event for documentation and communication purposes, such as publication on websites, social media, or related reports. For these processing activities— recording, photography, and dissemination — data subjects will be given the option to provide explicit consent during the registration process. Participation in these processing activities is voluntary, and the following options will be provided to individuals who do not give their consent: designated non-recorded areas or anonymised participation. In the case of minors between the ages of 13 and 18, EIT Raw Materials GmbH as controller of this processing operation shall share with the other controllers the consent of the minors already provided by the persons holding parental rights provided, in line with Article 8 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

Who has access to the personal data of data subjects, and to whom can they be disclosed?

Within the EIT:

For the purposes indicated above, access to personal data is provided to the EIT Director, the Head of Operations, the responsible Head of Unit, and EIT staff managing the event.

Within KICs (EIT Health e.V., EIT RawMaterials GmbH, EIT Manufacturing _ASBL, KIC InnoEnergy SE):

For the purposes indicated above, access to personal data is provided to the responsible Education and Communication project staff and management of EIT Health, EIT Raw Materials, EIT Manufacturing, KIC InnoEnergy SE taking part in the managing of the event.

Within the Commission and other EU institutions/bodies/agencies:

Video and audio recordings will be shared with the relevant staff of the European Commission Directorate General for Education and Culture, and other European Commission DG's upon request for dissemination purposes.

Exceptionally, authorised staff of the following EU institutions may have access to relevant personal data for audit control or investigation purposes: the Court of Auditors, the Internal Audit Service of the European Commission, European Anti-Fraud Office (OLAF).

For the purpose of handling review procedures and litigation, access to the personal data may also be granted to the European Ombudsman, the European Data Protection Supervisor, the General Court, and the European Court of Justice to the extent necessary for handling the review procedure and litigation.

What are the rights of the data subject?

In accordance with Articles 15, 17, 18, 19 of the Data Protection Regulation of European Institutions the data subjects have the **right for information**, the **right of access**, the **right of rectification** in case their personal data is not complete or not accurate and the **right to erasure** ("right to be forgotten").

Data subjects have the right to obtain the **erasure** of their personal data in accordance with Article 19 of the Regulation and in particular in the cases when the personal data are no longer necessary in relation to

the purposes for which they were collected, if the data subject withdraws its consent, or in case of unlawful processing. This means that data subjects may opt out of the processing of their personal data.

Data subjects also have the **right to restriction** of processing of personal data in accordance with Article 20 of the Regulation, and the **right to object** on grounds listed in Article 23 of the Regulation.

The rights of the data subjects can be exercised from the registration period and until the personal data is retained.

As a general rule, the requests for information, access, rectification, erasure restriction are handled without undue delay and in any event within 30 days of receipt of the request. This period may be extended by two further months, where necessary, taking into account the complexity and number of the request(s).

Restrictions to the rights of data subjects may be applied by the EIT, in accordance with Article 25 of the Data Protection Regulation of the European institutions and the EIT internal rules on restrictions⁶.

Grounds for lawfulness

EIT:

In line with Article 5(a) of Regulation No. (EU) 2018/1725, the processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the EIT.

In accordance with Article 5(d) of Regulation No. (EU) 2018/1725, the data subject can be added to the EIT Stakeholder Database in case he/she agrees, i.e. the data processing is lawful based on the consent of the data subject, for further information, please see the relevant privacy statement:

KICs:

In line with Article 6(1)(f) of GDPR, the data processing may be carried out on the basis of the legitimate interest of the KICs.

KICs are processing personal data on the basis of Article 6(1) of GDPR if personal data is required for the fulfillment of a contract or for the implementation of pre-contractual measures.
