





CELEBRATING EUROPE'S TOP INNOVATORS: WINNERS OF THE 2025 EIT INNOVATION AWARDS

Budapest, 25 November 2025 - The European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT) is proud to announce the winners of the 2025 EIT Innovation Awards, honouring Europe's standout innovators and entrepreneurial talents. The ceremony took place today in Budapest, bringing together the EIT Awards, honouring Europe's most promising innovators and their breakthrough solutions, the EIT Jumpstarter Grand Finale, showcasing startups from the Regional Innovation Scheme countries, and the EIT Red Kalyna awards, recognising outstanding Ukrainian women innovators.

This year's finalists come from across Europe, representing breakthrough ideas related to climate change, sustainable energy, digital transformation, health, sustainable food, raw materials, manufacturing and urban mobility. They reflect the diversity of innovators from the EIT Community – from concepts coming out of university research to fast-growing ventures already making a market impact. Selected from hundreds of teams across Europe, the finalists show how the EIT turns talent and research into scalable solutions that strengthen Europe's innovation capacity, boost competitiveness, and deliver value and solutions for citizens.

Antoaneta Angelova Krasteva, Director at the Directorate-General for Education, Youth, Sport and Culture of the European Commission, said: 'The EIT Awards highlight why Europe needs strong innovation ecosystems connecting education, research and business. These innovators show how entrepreneurship and collaboration can address real challenges that matter to citizens. We are committed to supporting this work and helping more talented Europeans turn their fledgling ideas into marketable solutions.'

Martin Kern, EIT Director, said: 'The innovators we celebrate today are outstanding examples of how European talent can turn strong ideas into impact. MEET THE WINNERS

2025 EIT Innovation Awards Categories

The **EIT Awards** celebrate high-impact innovations and the people behind them. Each award comes with a monetary prize of €50 000 (first place), €30 000 (second place), and €20 000 (third place).

• Changemaker Award – for a standout leader and role model whose activities create significant social impact. This year's winner is <u>Laura Laringe</u> (Germany), nominated by InnoEnergy, for cofounding reLi Energy, which improves battery performance through smart software.





- Innovation Team Award for a diverse group from across the education, research, and business fields, pioneering a groundbreaking product or service with transformative potential. This year's winner is Al Automated Industrial Analytics (Italy), nominated by EIT Manufacturing, for developing an Al tool that quickly detects issues in manufacturing and helps workers make better decisions using real time data.
- **Venture Award** for an emerging startup within the EIT Community demonstrating exceptional promise and growth potential. This year's winner is <u>ABLE Human Motion</u> (Spain), nominated by EIT Health, for developing affordable motorised wearable robotic frames (exoskeletons) that help people to walk again and support their rehabilitation.
- **Public Award** The community's favourite innovation, selected by public online vote. This year's winner is ABLE Human Motion (Spain).
